"The Sexual Revolution and Its Consequences" explores the history, ideology, and impact of the radical liberalization and politicization of sexuality that achieved its full force beginning in the late 1960s and 1970s and has continuedits expansion ever since. Without neglecting cultural factors, emphasis is placed on the political dimension: principal demands and grievances, sexual ideology, creation of organizations, legislative achievements, judicial decisions, globalization, plus the major consequences (intended and unintended) and organized opposition from traditionalists, religious believers, heterosexuals, and others. Some less obvious effects of the Revolution are highlighted, and the series concludes with suggestions on how we can respond effectively as the Sexual Revolution attempts to introduce continued innovations that push us further towards sexual liberation and experimentation.
